**C**arol Ann Razi, 81, of St. Petersburg, Florida, passed away on Saturday, October 19, 2019. Born November 3, 1937. She was the daughter of the late William and Katherine (Ilasenko) Rockliff.

She was born and raised in Detroit, Michigan. She was Salutatorian of her class at East Commerce High and earned speed awards in typing and shorthand. Following graduation, she attended the University of Detroit and Wayne State University in addition to working at the Detroit Public School System. She married Dr. Dean M. Razi in 1960 and they started their family together.

In 1976, the family moved to St. Petersburg, Florida. She was an officer of the Pinellas County Medical Auxiliary for many years and also worked in Dr. Razi's office as a medical secretary and receptionist.

Although near the end of her life, she physically was not able to care for Rusty, she was always overjoyed when Rusty came for a visit.
