Dr. Paschal Jay Collins died Friday, June 24th after a protracted battle with the symptoms of dementia. He was 88 years old. He leaves behind large swaths of family throughout Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, North Carolina, and Ohio.

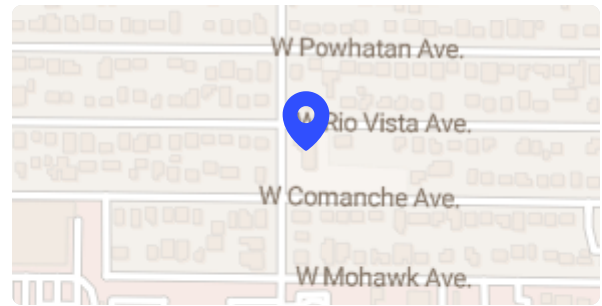
