Unfortunately, schizophrenia, bipolar disorder and self medication lead her into a downward spiral from which she never recovered. Even still, she had a heart of gold, a great sense of humor and compassion for those who struggled through life.

Rachel is survived by one 5yr old son, Malacchi Roberts, four siblings; Victoria Felder, Shayla Bush, Jasmine Graham & John Graham Jr., her mother, Talmeca Graham, her grandmother, Cynthia Roberts, her uncle who was more like a big brother, John Jacobs II (Dominique Jacobs) and a host of cousins, aunties and uncles.

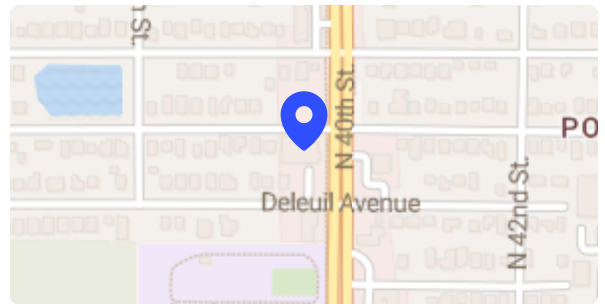
